JERSEY INTERNATIONAL AIR DISPLAY 2022 - AIRSPACE LIMITATIONS

- 1 Practice for the Jersey International Air Display will take place **between 1200 and 1600 on Wednesday 7 September 2022**.
- 2 The Jersey International Air Display will take place between 1200 and 1600 on Thursday 8 September 2022.

3 Airspace affected within the Channel Islands CTR:

- a) Lateral Limits: 15 NM radius centred on 491229N 0021144W (Jersey Airport);
- b) Vertical Limits: Surface to FL 80.

4 Airspace affected within the Channel Islands TMA:

- a) Lateral Limits: 15 NM radius centred on 491229N 0021144W (Jersey Airport);
- b) Vertical Limits: FL 80 to FL 120.

5 Restricted Airspace (Temporary)


- 5.1 In accordance with Article 47 of the Air Navigation (Jersey) Law 2014; The Director of Civil Aviation has established Restricted Airspace (Temporary) as follows:
 - a) Between 1145 and 1600 on Wednesday 7 September 2022.
 - b) Between 1145 and 1600 on Thursday 8 September 2022.
- 5.2 RA(T) Dimensions:

Circle radius 6 NM centred at 491125N 0020751W from SFC to FL 120.

- 5.3 This restriction shall not apply to:
 - a) Any aircraft flying with the permission of the Head of Air Navigation Services;
 - b) Any aircraft under the control of Jersey ATC;
 - c) Any Aircraft flying for the purpose of Search and Rescue or for the purpose of saving life;
 - d) Any Aircraft flying with the permission of the flying display director.

6 Remarks

- 6.1 The practice sessions and the Jersey International Air Display will take place approximately 1.5 NM South East of Jersey Airport.
- 6.2 Solo and formation aerobatics will take place.
- 6.3 The Class A Airspace detailed in paragraph 4 is classified as Class D Airspace from **1100 on Wednesday 7 September to 2030 on Thursday 8 September 2021**.
- 6.4 It is possible that aircraft may experience delays whilst these activities are taking place.
- 6.5 Air traffic movements will be suspended from **1520 to 1600 on Thursday 8 September** to facilitate formation team aerobatics by the Red Arrows.
- 7 Aerodrome PPR restrictions as identified by NOTAM.
- 8 Due to limited parking, all non-commercial, non-local light aircraft must ensure that they book in with their appropriate handling agent.
